With a 100/100 score: medal and 1st absolute prize diploma; with score from 95 to 99/100 1st prize diploma; with score 90 to 94/100 2nd prize diploma; with a score of 85 to 90/100 a 3rd prize diploma; with a score of less than 85, certificate of participation.

All participants with a 100/100 mark must perform at the final evening for the category scholarship (€ 300.00 diploma and 1st prize medal), all the finalists will also compete for the Global Music Awards Special Prize. The winner will receive a scholarship € 1000.00 + Diploma and medal (in this case the scholarship will not be assigned).

General rules

Art. 1 - The Municipality of Bracigliano in collaboration with "Oltre" Associazione No-Profit and the Artistic-Musical Direction of Maestro Francesco Cardaropoli, proclaims and organizes the International Competition of Music Execution "Young Promises" which will take place from 10 to 18 May 2019; place of the competition: De Simone palace - street Vittorio Emanuele, BRACIGLIANO (SA) - Italy.

Art. 2 - The International Competition is born with the aim of promoting the comparison between young musicians newcomers or already enriched by significant experiences that, in a climate of dialogue and cultural exchange, show their talent for the affirmation of the second between the seven Arts of the Muses through an empathetic relationship between them and the public.

Art. 3 - The application for registration, as per the attached model, together with the payment of the participation fee, must be sent by April 19, 2019 to the following addresses: Competition Secretariat: "Oltre" Associazione No-Profit, Via Vescovo Capaccio, 99 - 84082 Bracigliano (Sa) – Italy or: concorsobracigliano@gmail.com - mobile 389 261 38 74 (also WhatsApp), Facebook, Young promises contest Bracigliano. Call, application form and entry to the competition can be downloaded directly on the website: www.concorsogiovanipromessebracigliano.it or on the website of the Municipality of Bracigliano. Any questions that have been reached after the deadline will be accepted at the discretion of the Organizing Committee; incomplete applications will not be accepted. All certificates will be issued in the final evening and will not be sent to competitors.

Art. 5 - The Competition schedule will be announced on 5 May 2019 and competitors are required to obtain information on the following contacts: mobile 389 261 38 74 (also whatsapp); concorsobracigliano@gmail.com The calendars, moreover, will be published on the Competition Site and on Facebook.

Art. 6 - The vote is expressed in cents, for a maximum of 100/100 and the prizes will be awarded for each category with the following criterion:

I ° 100/100 Absolute Prize I ° Prize, score from 95 to 99/100 II ° Prize, score from 90 to 94/100 3rd Prize, score from 85 to 89/100 In case of ex-aequo the prize will be divided All participants will receive a certificate of participation.

Art. 7 - All the competitors, upon their arrival at the Competition venue, must go to the Registrar's Office for registration and must be present at least 30 minutes before the start of each Section / Category, as indicated by the calendar of tests that will be promptly communicated according to the provisions of art. 5. The Jury will have the right to admit late candidates.

Art. 8 - Competitors must present themselves in the tests with: a) A document of recognition; in the case of Instrumental Groups, a single list will be provided by the School indicating the names and classes attended; b) two copies of the pieces to be performed for the Commission.

Art. 9 - The Competitors of the "Soloists" categories will be able to choose whether to present a piece by instrument alone or accompanied by the piano. In this last case they will have to provide the accompanying

person autonomously. For those who request it, the organization will indicate the names of accompanying pianists with whom the competitor will freely take the appropriate agreements.

Art. 10 - The Competition is divided into sections and categories: each of which is distributed by age groups.

Art. 11 - The signing of the application for participation implies the unconditional acceptance of the regulation governing the competition and the registration fees are not refundable. The organization reserves the right to delete one or more categories if it does not consider sufficient the number of registered competitors. In the latter case, the registration fee will be refunded.

Art. 12 - Each participant may sign in more than one section or in a category above their age if they consider that their technical and artistic preparation allows it, but cannot participate in a lower category.

Art. 13 - The Jury, nominated by the Organizing Committee, will be made up of Lecturers, Orchestra Professors and renowned Musicians who will not have the right to vote if they have kinship relationships with the competitors. The Jury can be divided, if necessary, into sub-commissions. **The judgment of the Jury is unquestionable, unappealable and definitive. It has the right to stop executions at any time.**

Art. 14 - PRIZES: the participants and the winners will be rewarded as specified below: the Third classified will be awarded a third place diploma; the Second classified will be awarded with a second place diploma; First place will be awarded with a medal and a first place diploma. You can have, at the discretion of the commission, more awarded between the 1st - 2nd and 3rd place.

Art. 15 - The Organizing Committee reserves the right to make any changes to the present Regulations

Art. 16 - Pursuant to art. 10 of Law n. 675/96 on "Protection of personal data" "Oltre" Non-profit Association informs that the data provided at the time of registration will be kept and used by the same in order to send communications relating to the competition and that, pursuant to art. 129 of the aforementioned law, the data owner may object to their use. All tests will be open to the public. Travel and accommodation expenses for participation in the Review are to be paid by the candidates who, by signing the registration form, declare their consent to the processing of personal data pursuant to GDPR, *General Data Protection Regulation - UE 2016/679*. In case of registration and / or radio, television or Internet transmission of the Competition tests, candidates will not have any right to request compensation for the organization of the Competition. Photographic, video and audio material may be used for information purposes (GDPR, *General Data Protection Regulation - UE 2016/679*). For any eventual controversy the Court of Nocera Inferiore will be competent.
